
## MY BARBARIAN

My Barbarian is an immersive survey of the collective's work over the last two decades. The three-channel video, created on the occasion of this exhibition, features performances for the camera, video documentation of live performances, photographs, and previously unreleased footage drawn from the group's extensive archive. Along with the projected triptych, the artists have animated a selection of artworks including sculptures, paintings, drawings, masks, textiles, costumes, and puppets—using theatrical lighting that corresponds to the videos. Together, these wide-ranging works surface pivotal themes across the collective's output, including referencing their founding in the Los Angeles DIY club scene, using site-specific spectacles performed at a range of international venues, responding to performance methods and theory, and creating art that is inextricable from the times and context in which it is made.




